

Reasons to Shop Local This Holiday Season

1. Supports Job Creation Locally

Small businesses in Canada employ 10.7 million individuals which is almost two-thirds (63.0%) of all employees. By comparison, businesses with 100 to 500 employees employed 3.6 million individuals (21.0% of employees), and businesses with more than 500 employees employed 2.7 million individuals (16.0% of employees).

2. Puts Money Back into Our Community

Shopping local contributes to our community. For every \$100 you spend locally, \$63 remains in the community — compared to as little as \$14 from some big box stores and online retailers.

3. It's Better for the Environment

Shopping locally benefits the environment by reducing carbon emissions, conserving energy, preserving natural resources, and supporting sustainable practices.

4. Support for Local Community Groups and Non-profits

Local businesses are more likely to invest in their people, join local fundraisers, support sport teams, and run campaigns that benefit their community than their national counterparts.

Small businesses donate 250% more than larger businesses to local non-profits and community causes.

5. Healthier and Tastier Holiday Meals

Huron County produces a lot of food! Purchasing ingredients for your holiday spread from local producers and growers provides a fresher, healthier, and tastier way to indulge and entertain this season.
